

Will of Henry Gadfield (- 1716)
Minster Lovell, Oxfordshire

Gadfield Hen: de Minster Lovell

In the Name of God Amen. First and Principally I bequeath my soul unto the hands of Almighty God that gave [...] trusting in Gods [...] free pardon for all my sins & offences that I have committed And as for my Body to be Interred at the Discretion of my Executrix hereafter mentioned. Item I give and bequeath to my Son Henry Gadfield one Guinea of good & lawful money to be paid him by my Executor within six months after my Decease. Item I give & bequeath to my som Thomas Gadfield one Guinea of Good & Lawful money to be paid him by my Executrix within six months after my decease. All the Rest of my Goods & Chattles unbequeath I give & bequeath unto my loving Wife Sarah Gadfield whom I make my whole & sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testament Revoking all former Wills and paying all my Debts & Legacys whatsoever and I do farther order it that what my Wife Sarah Gadfield shall die [...] of go to my Daughter Sarah ye wife of James Thaylor & her her Heirs and I do nominate Richard Harris & Moses Brooks [...] to this my last Will and Testament and to see that my Wife be not wronged of any thing and that she her self do not unadvisedly squander it any. In Witness where of I have hereunto sett my hand and seal this Thirtith Day of July Anno Domi 1716 Henry Gadfield signed sealed & declared in ye presence of us Henry Carter, Abel Brooks.
